The Social Coastal A hilly coast to coast challenge showcasing some of Cornwall's finest coast and country. Starting in Wadebridge, the route crosses south through china clay country to the Roseland Peninsula passing through Mevagissey and neighbouring bays. After the route breaks away from the coast it heads back north through the Ladock valley to Indian Queens and then on to north coast, arriving at Padstow before heading along the Camel trail to the finish.
